

## ARTICLES OF THE RAJASTHAN STATE SPORTS COUNCIL

- (1) The name of the Society is and shall be the "Rajasthan State Sports Council" and it shall be hereinafter referred to as the "COUNCIL".
- (2) The registered Office of the Rajasthan State Sports Council shall be situated in Jaipur and is at present at SB- 160, Bapunagar, Gandhinagar Marg, Jaipur-4.

The constitution, powers and functions of the Rajasthan State Sports Council shall be as follows:-

- (1) PATRON & VICE-PATRONS:- The Government shall be Patron of the Council and the following shall be its two Vice-Patrons:-
- (i) The Chief Minister of Rajasthan Senior Vice-Patron.
  - (ii) His Highness the Maharaja of Jaipur- Vice-Patron.

- (2) COMPOSITION: The Council shall consist of:-

- (i) President (Chief Executive)
- (ii) Vice-President
- (iii) Treasurer
- (iv) Six official-ex officio members
- (v) Not more than twelve members, out of whom atleast one shall be woman nominated by the State Government.

Provided that no person who is an office bearer of State Sports Federation/Association shall be eligible for nomination as President, Vice-President or any other member of the Council becomes such an office bearer, he or she shall cease to be president, Vice-President or other member of the Council.

- (a) The Council shall be a body corporate with its Memorandum of Association incorporating the relevant

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- (a) The Council shall be a body corporate with its



Memorandum of Association incorporating the relevant portion of the order.

(b) Nomination to the Council made by the Government shall be valid for a period of three years on less such nomination is withdrawn earlier.

(3) Term of the Council:- The duration of the Council shall be a period of three years from the date of its constitution.

(4) Functions and Powers:- The Council shall exercise and perform the following powers and functions, namely:-

- (i) to plan and promote the all-round development of games, sports, physical culture and physical education;
- (ii) to organize training, coaching and education in sports, games and physical culture and to establish and maintain facilities for the same;
- (iii) to maintain libraries, reading rooms and museums relating to games, sports, physical culture and physical education for the use of members, recognized associations and also the general public;
- (iv) to advise the State Sports Organizations and to act as the coordinating agency amongst them;
- (v) to advise the State Government in all matter concerning sports and games including any financial and other assistance to sports organizations;
- (vi) to set up such abhor committees or sub-committees as it may think fit in connection with any of its activities;
- (vii) to affiliate or disaffiliate, or recognize, withdraw recognition of any association.
- (viii) to issue directions on matters of general policy to associations and other bodies receiving grant from the Council;
- (ix) to receive grant and donations from the State Government or from any other source or from both;
- (x) To utilize in its discretion, funds of the Council in furtherance of the objectives for which the Council is established.
- (xi) to arrange for the audit of accounts of the bodies affiliated to or recognized by the Council.

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- (xi) to arrange for the audit of accounts of the bodies affiliated to or recognized by the Council.
- (xii) to conserve or protect accounts, loss or damage to its

The Vice-President shall in the absence (for whatever reason) of the President, preside at the meeting of the Council and all committees of which the President is the Chairman and while doing so, shall exercise the powers and perform all the functions of the President.

(iii) In the absence of both the President and Vice-President the Council shall elect from amongst themselves a Chairman who will preside over the meeting and exercise and perform all the powers and functions of the President.

(7) Council Meeting :-

(i) The Council shall hold two general meetings in a year at a place and on a date to be fixed by it at the previous meeting or by the President, if no date or place is fixed by the Council of the two general meetings, one shall be held in summer and the other in Winter, preferably in the months of June and December, respectively (hereinafter called the Summer Meetings and the Winter Meetings respectively).

(ii) The following business shall be transacted at the Summer Meeting:-

(a) Consideration of the Annual Report prepared by the Standing Committee. This report shall contain a review of the affairs and a statement of accounts of the Council for the previous year.

(b) Appointment of Auditors.

(c) Consideration of other proposals or matters which the Standing Committee or any other member of the council may wish to make or bring before the

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(8) Special Meeting of the Council :-

- (i) A special meeting of the Council may be convened at any time by the President of the Council either on his own initiative or at the request, in writing, of not less than 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the number of Members of the Council.
- (ii) A request for convening a special meeting of the Council shall be accompanied by a statement of the purpose in the form of proposal and discussion at the meeting shall be confined only to the consideration of such proposal.
- (iii) The notice for a special meeting shall be given seven days before the date of such meeting.

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(9) Standing Committee :-

(i) There shall be Standing Committee of the Council constituted by the State Government which shall consist of :-

- (i) The President,
  - (ii) The Vice-President,
  - (iii) The Treasurer and
  - (iv) Not more than two other members of the Council.
- Provided that out of the five members of the Standing Committee on at least shall be a woman.
- (ii) The duration of Standing Committee shall be ~~to~~ not less than six months with that of the Council

(f) to make, subject to the general direction of the Council grants :-  
(i) to Bodies, associations, organizations and clubs.  
(ii) for other sports activities.  
(iii) for the betterment of sports and games and  
(iv) any other deserving cases relating to games and sports.

(g) to provide by regulations, with the previous approval of the Council, for giving grant-in-aid to persons and associations etc. referred to in clause (f)

(h) in cases of such emergency to take such actions as may be necessary to meet emergency and to report its actions to the Council at its next general meeting, and.

(i) The Standing Committee may, by order in writing, delegate to any of the office bearers powers conferred upon it by this article, other than those contained in

**(10) Procedure & Quorum :-**

- (i) All matters at the meeting of the Council and the Standing Committee shall be decided by a majority of votes. If votes are equally divided, the President shall give his casting vote.
- (ii) The Quorum to constitute a meeting of the Council shall be seven members and that for the standing committee shall be three members.

**(11) Financial Year :-** The financial year of the Council shall be the year commencing on the first day of April and ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March next following.

**(12) Funds of the Council :-**

- (i) The Council shall establish a fund to be called the Council Fund.
- (ii) All grants or donations received by the Council from the Govt. and any other source or all other moneys received on behalf of the Council shall form part of, or be deposited into the Council Fund.
- (iii) The funds of the Council shall be deposited in a Scheduled Bank in Jaipur, who shall be the Bankers of the Council.
- (iv) The matters to which the Council Fund should be applied and appropriated should be those provided in this order or which are prescribed by rule made by Council after obtaining previous approval of the Government.
- (v) The accounts with the Bankers shall be operated upon and cheques signed by, any two of the following office bearers of the Council;

- i) President
- ii) Vice-President
- iii) Treasurer
- iv) Secretary

(13) Accounts and Audit :-

- (i) Annual accounts and balance sheets of the Council shall be prepared by the Treasurer under the direction of the Standing Committee and all moneys accruing to or received by the Council from whatever source and all amount disbursed or paid shall be entered in the accounts.
- (ii) Such accounts shall be audited by Auditors who shall be Chartered Accountants and cost of such audit shall be charged on the Council Fund.
- (iii) The copies of the accounts along with audit report shall be submitted by the Vice-President to the Council, as also to the State Government along with observations of the Council, if any.

(14) Amendment of Constitution :- without prejudice to the powers of the State Government in this behalf, the Council may by a majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting and after obtaining the previous approval of the State Government, amend this Constitution.
